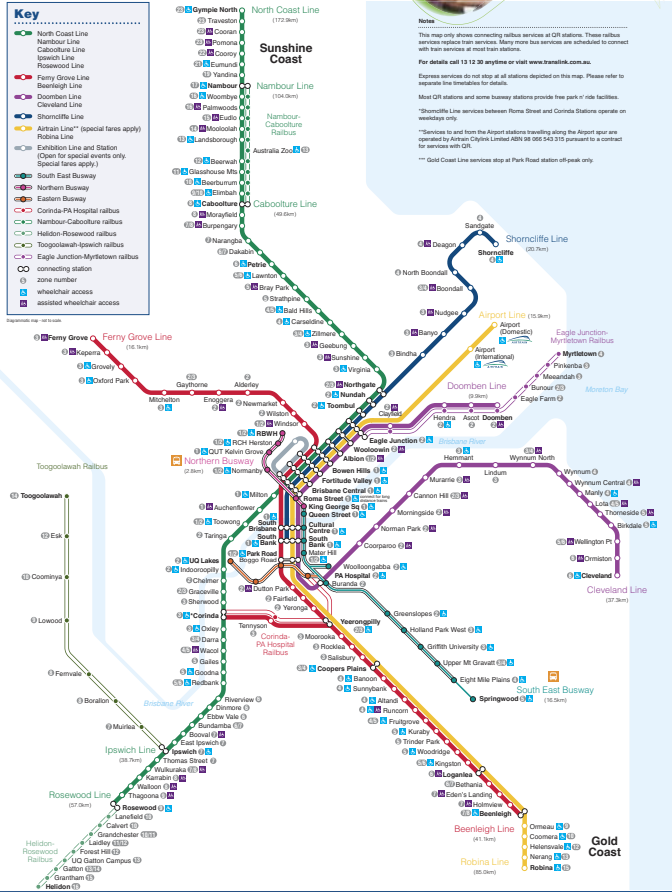
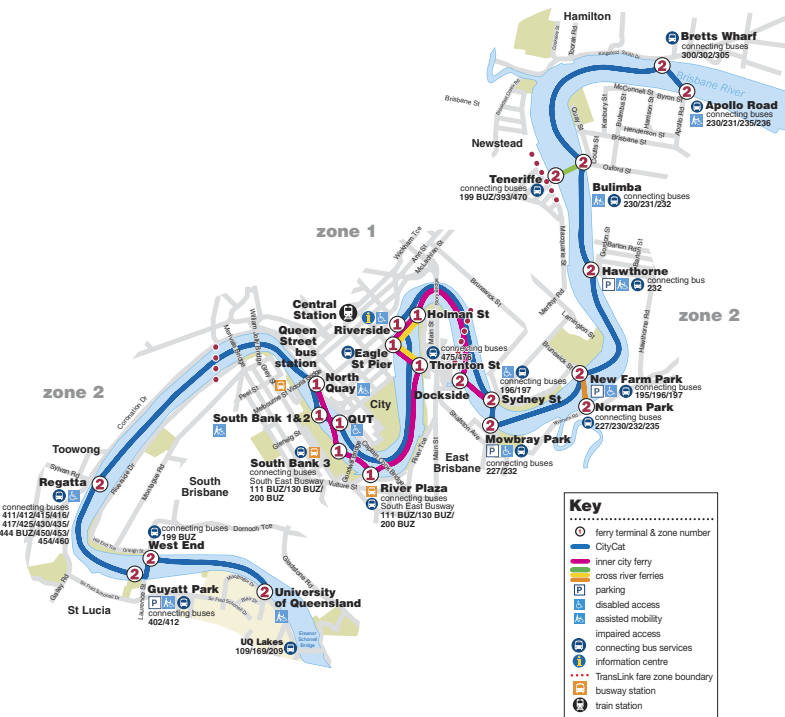

## Self Guided Walking Tours



### ROUTE 1 - HISTORICAL TOUR

- Queen Street Mall** - Over 700 specialty stores and the Visitor Information centre - Ask friendly staff for advice or bookings.
- Brisbane City Hall & King George Square**
- The Old Windmill** - Built by convicts in 1828, it was used for both grinding corn and punishment.
- Jacobs Ladder** - Built in 1961, the stairs link Wickham Terrace with Edward Street through King Edward Park.
- Anzac Square memorial** - Dedicated to Australia's military heritage.
- GPO Building** - Neo-classical architecture built in 1872.
- St. Stephens** - A neo-gothic design that was built in 1850.
- Macarthur Museum** - Dedicated to Brisbane's involvement in WWII.
- Conrad Treasury** - Originally the government's treasury.
- Conrad Treasury Brisbane Hotel** - One of Australia's grandest heritage buildings.
- Commissariat Store** - Originally built by convicts in 1829.
- George Street Mansions** - Built in 1890 as 6 eloquent 3-storey terrace houses.
- Parliament House** - Built in 1868 in a French Renaissance style.
- QUT Art Museum** - A neo-classical revivalist design that now houses classic contemporary Australian art.

- Old Government House** - Completed in 1862, it's a rare survivor from early colonial days.
- River Mangrove Boardwalk** - Discover a rare ecosystem.

### ROUTE 2 - ART & ARCH. TOUR

- Queen Street Mall** - See Route 1.
- Scrap Metal Kangaroos** - The most photographic creatures in the city.
- Brisbane Square** - Abstract modern forms contrast the old treasury building.
- Around the Camp Fires** - Sculptures - originally part of World Expo 1988.
- Confluence** - Sophisticated artwork by Daniel Templeman.
- The State Law Building** - A modern/gothic design nicknamed "The Batman Building."
- King George Square** - Brisbane City Hall towers over the public-square.
- Roma Street Parklands** - Spectacular sub-tropical gardens.
- Anzac Square** - Dedicated to Australia's military heritage.
- Dialogue** - These Bronze sculptures are more human than human!
- The Overseer** - A delightfully human sculpture balancing over shoppers below.
- Mooney Memorial Fountain** - Dedicated to fireman who died in 1877.
- Customs House** - A stunning neo-classical design built in the 1880's.

- Chat** - A unique cast aluminum sculpture by Sebastian Di Mauro.
- Riverside** - Take a walk along the Brisbane River promenade.
- Waterfront Place** - One of Brisbane's landmark office towers.
- Festival Hall** - A gallery honours the greats who've played there, like the Beatles and Led Zeppelin.
- Resonance** - An unusual Granite sculpture by Chee Fong Hew.
- Queen Victoria Statue** - Centrepiece of Queens Park - completed in 1906.
- Former State Library Mosaic** - A colourful design by Lindsay Edwards.

### ROUTE 3 - CITY TO SOUTHBANK

- Queen Street Mall** - See Route 1.
- Kurilpa Bridge** - A pedestrian and bicycle bridge that links the city centre and South Brisbane.
- GoMA** - Australia's largest Gallery of Modern Art.
- State Library of Queensland** - Exhibitions, talks and tours, film screenings and school holiday workshops.
- Queensland Museum & Science Centre** - Hands on encounters with fascinating exhibitions like the Mephisto, Dinosaur Garden, Dandiiri Maiwar and offers science based fun for kids of all ages.
- Queensland Art Gallery** - Inspiring art collections with visual art exhibitions.
- Queensland Performing Arts Centre** - World-class entertainment.

- Queensland Conservatorium** - One of Australia's leading tertiary music institutions.
- Wheel of Brisbane** - Get a panoramic view of the city and surrounds.
- Southbank Parklands** - Lush gardens, fantastic food and shopping, as well as Australia's only inner-city beach.
- Queensland Maritime Museum** - Tour a 1945 Australian Navy frigate.
- Goodwill Bridge** - A foot bridge that links the city with South Bank.

- Queen Street Mall** - See Route 1.
- Botanic Gardens**
- Take the Riverwalk past Eagle Street Pier**
- Past Customs House**
- Along the walkway to below the Story Bridge and Howard Smith Wharfs**
- Climb up Ivory Lane**
- Across the Story Bridge**
- Down Thornton Street Stairs to the river walk**
- Past Riverlife Adventure Centre**
- Kangaroo Point Cliffs**
- Over the Goodwill Bridge and back to the Botanic Gardens**
